

- 3. Sunday is the most special day for the Church called the Lord's Day.
- 4. The celebration of the Lord's Day lasts from <u>Saturday evening</u> through Sunday midnight.
- 5. We worship God at Mass every <u>Sunday</u> because it is the day that Jesus rose from the dead.
