 - o Title I guidelines will be given at a meeting on May 16
- □ Strategic Plan
 - o New plan will run from 2018-2022
 - o Goal 1: Reading
 - By 2022 the percentage of students who will read proficiently by the end of this grade will increase to 63%.
 - o Goal 2: Math I
 - 75% percent of incoming sixth grade students will pass NC Math I (Algebra I) with a C or better by the end of their ninth grade year in 2022
 - o Goal 3: Career Pathways
 - By 2022, the percentage of graduating seniors who complete a rigorous career pathway will increase to 35%.
 - o Goal 4: Exceed Growth
 - By 2022, increase by 50% the number of schools that exceed growth.
 - o Goal 5: Decrease Gaps
 - By 2022, decrease the achievement gap between black and Latino students and their white peers by 7 percentage points.
 - Goal 6: Increase Efficiency
 - By 2022, increase organizational efficiency and effectiveness to better support student learning.

 - o 3-5 students earn 'steps' every 15 minutes they read at home
