GET YOUR BOATING LICENSE!

The boating course covers: safety, rules of the road, operating requirements, personal watercraft, New Jersey specific laws, and much more. All our classes are multi-day classes completed in two (2) sessions and include one (1) hour of homework between the sessions and the proctored exam. If you receive an 80% or better on your written exam, you will walk away with a usable temporary license. Taking a one-day course is a difficult way to learn the information and we do not recommend it. Our two-day course has a 98% pass rate. Remember, a boating safety course will increase your knowledge and add to your confidence. We are here to make boating safer and therefore more fun! Please note that students aged 12 and older can register*.

Students must be 16 years of age or older to be eligible for the license.*

*Students aged 13-15 can get certified and operate anything 12' and longer but under 10 horsepower. 12-year-olds can take the course, pass and will then have to contact the vendor when student turns 13 to get certified. 16 year-olds can take anything including jet skis up to 40' long.
