As you already know, Guilford County Schools has decided to begin the school year remotely. Beginning with the first day of school students will login to Canvas daily. To login, students will need their student ID #. Please contact the school if you do not know your child's student ID #. Students will have recorded lessons daily with assignments to complete. Students will turn in assignments to teachers. Assignments will be graded and student attendance will be monitored by classroom teachers.

We are currently finalizing schedules and hope to have those available later next week. Once you have your child's homeroom teacher's name, you can go onto our school website or Facebook page and sign up for an individual virtual or face to face orientation session. Those conferences will begin the first week of school. Each grade level will also have a virtual open house during the first week of school. Stay tuned for more information on that.

If your child needs a device and does not still have one from last year we will have a link next week on our website and Facebook page for you to let us know. You can also call the front office. Devices will be limited, however to start the school year. If you still have a school issued device from last school year, you can come by the school and log into the device after connecting to the school network. This will allow the device to make necessary updates. This can be done from our school parking lot.
