The district sent communication earlier today that schools will continue to be closed for students on Wednesday, January 19th. All extra-curricular activities and athletics are also canceled tomorrow.

Last Friday teachers spent some time reviewing with students how to access the assignments for tomorrow and where to navigate to get onto the Microsoft Teams calls during remote learning days.
