Good evening Tigers this is Mr. W, principal of Kiser Middle School, with several announcements for the upcoming week!

The first day of school for students is Monday, August 23rd.

Student schedules and welcome letters were mailed on Thursday, August 12th for all students who completed a SchoolMint registration before August 5th. Students who registered between August 5th and the 12th will pick up their schedule at Open House. We will also email the schedule through PowerSchool as well similar to how report cards were delivered during the 3rd quarter of last school year.

We are excited to welcome our students and families on Tuesday, August 17th for Open House. Our goal is to provide everyone an opportunity to meet their teachers, and for our new students to begin to get comfortable with the building as safely as possible. The Open House will be staggered by alphabet with the times listed below to reduce the number of people in the building at one time, and we also encourage families to limit the number of people that come with your student. Students and families should bring their schedule and report to the doors leading into each grade level wing from the car rider line, which is in the back of the building down the driveway across from the Grimsley tennis courts. We encourage our families to park in the Grimsley High School football stadium parking lot and walk down the driveway to where we will have our registration tables setup. We will have a registration table at each door and only those students whose last name is scheduled during that time will be permitted to enter the building. At the end of each time slot we are asking students and families to exit the doors between the gym and cafeteria, front office, or side exits to cut down on the number of people at the registration doors. Also, everyone must have a mask on for all events at school regardless of vaccination status. There will be representatives from the PTA, district transportation, athletics, and the office staff to help with any registration questions in the Kiser courtyard. - Complete important information links provided.
- Visit the courtyard for information on transportation, athletics, and PTA
- Visit the front office if you need to submit a medication authorization form.
