- I. <u>Celebrations</u>
 - a. NGMS Exceeded Expected Growth based on testing for 2018-2019 school year
 - b. Good implementation of MVP curriculum for Math I
- II. <u>Review 2018-19 Data (including subgroup data)</u>
 - a. Handouts of subgroup data were shared
 - i. Grade Level Proficiency—77.5 (up 8 points from last year)
 - ii. All subgroups had an increase in EVAAS Growth Index
 - iii. NGMS "met" EVAAS Growth Status in all subgroup areas and "exceeded" in the following areas: all students, Black, Hispanic, and Economically Disadvantaged.
 - iv. Proficiency Growth in all areas from 2018 to 2019
 - 1. Reading-69.2 to 75.5
 - 2. Math—66.3 to 75.3
 - 3. Science—81.1 to 88.7
 - b. NGMS is on the right track now to just continue the upward movement. The goal to not just get students to proficiency but once they are there, continue to grow them.
- III. Updating of by-laws to include representation from all feeder schools and grade levels

NGMS By-law change for Parent Representatives:

Motion: NGMS SBLT will have 6 parent representatives representing each grade level and feeder elementary school areas with no more than 2 parents representing each feeder area.
