MTAC – Media and Tech Advisory Committee

SIP goals – district set the 3%age points

1. Math by 6/2025 math will increase by 3%age points from 69.9 to 72.9
2. Reading by 6/2025 reading will increase by 3 %age points from 66.7 to 69.7
3. Science by 6/2025 science will increase by 3%age points from 86.3 to 89.3
4. Chronic absences by 6/2025 the percentage of students who were chronically absent will decrease by 5 %age points from 28.3 to 23.3
5. Lost Instructional Days: by 6/2025, the number of lost instructional days due to In-School Suspensions and Out of School Suspensions will be decreased by 10% from 275.81 days to 248 days. (124.63 ISS + 151.17 OSS = 275.81)

MTSS and tutoring

1. GCS tutoring ESSR funds is gone
2. GCS encourages Homework Helpline for all students 3rd thru Math 3. Reading is thru 8th grade. Free. Online. A teacher different than the student's classroom teacher. Teachers are GCS employees and are paid with funding.
3. GCS looked at data. Our K-3 need literacy help. Middle school need is math. Tutors will only work in these subject areas.
4. NGMS will only get 2 tutors for math. We asked last year's math tutors to come back. MTSS students in ELA in tier 2 how will we get tier 3 interventions to these students. Tutor cannot progress monitor math students.
 - a. Ideas on how to Progress Monitor tier 3 ELA and PM math students. Think outside box. Not just on math

and ela students. MTSS is a schoolwide program. CBM fluency for reading. Math tier 2 is grade level standards. Tier 3 students have individualized goals. Math automaticity and Math CAP are used to PM students.

5. Title 1 schools have to follow same guidelines. Title 1 schools get title 1 funds. Non-title 1 schools get donated money from businesses for tutoring funds
