We were given an additional \$23,000 - Would like to give the money to 2nd grade and Ms. Kube and Ms. Thompson for rugs, some money to Saturday academy for 3 Saturday for 8 teachers, and more teachers would be able to tutor however you have to fill out an application which is due on Friday.

- Tutoring
 - Tutoring will start the week of January 15th – will be on Wednesday and Thursdays 2:30 – 3:30 and will be paid \$40 an hour and paid for an hour of planning (3:30 – 4:00). Working on a plan for what it will look like for 3rd and 4th.
 - \$25,000 was placed in a tutoring account last year. Students will be selected based on interim data, projected data, ect. If you have a student that tested well but you believe needs tutoring and you have data to back that up – speak with admin.
 - Math tutoring will be from Zearn, however, students will not be on their devices for an hour. Tutors can pull activities from Zearn. Snacks will be provided from the cafeteria.
 - Right now tutoring is 2 – 5 but additional funding will provide for more grade levels and more teachers.
 - 10 students per teacher except for upper grades, they may can have more students.
 - Admin will be looking at EVAAS data from teachers and from students and will place students according to teacher strengths
 - If teacher does not have EVAAS data, admin will
 - April 6th , April 27th and May 18th (tentatively) 3.5 hours – different application that staff has not received. You do not have to teach on all three Saturdays – that would be ideal however we can have a floating sub (3rd, 4th, and 5th) for higher students
