Testing update: There is a power school issue across the state, and no one has any scores back. Scores should be back tomorrow. As soon as the team gets it, they will share scores with teachers.

Dibels Data:

- Proficient: Kindergarten 52%, 1st grade 42%, 2nd grade 34%, 3rd grade 36%
- As a school: 35% moved up from below or well below
- K 33% average
- 1st grade 43% average
- 2nd grade 29% average and 19% moved up one level
- 3rd grade: 63% average, 38% moved up, 22% moved up from below/well below

Rosters for next year:

- Students will not be assigned to a teacher – teachers will be assigned over the summer
- Think about students that can be together and separate lows and highs
- Form from Alston
 - Notes to next teacher – behaviors and make sure they are soft and general
