Our Plan to meet ESSA Requirements:

- Annual meeting: We will plan out annual parent Title I meeting to take place during the 1st quarter of the 2021-2022 school year.
- Flexible meetings: Our flexible SBLT (School Based Leadership Team) meetings will take place, at least, monthly. Those dates will be in the 2021-2022 staff handbook, 2021-2022 student handbook and 2021-2022 parent handbook.
- Involve parents in the development of PFE plan and the Title I program: We have a parent representative on our SBLT team. We are hoping to gain at least 1 more parent representative for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Provide Information to parents: We will provide information to parents over class DOJO, in weekly connect eds and in weekly teacher newsletters.
- Allow for comments on plans: We will ask for feedback/comments on the Title I plan on an ongoing basis.
