

## Eligibility for SAT/ACT Fee Waiver

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your child may be eligible for a fee waiver for registration for the SAT/ACT. Below you will find the eligibility criteria for fee waivers. Parents/Guardians must provide the appropriate documentation listed below to your child's school counselor in order to receive fee waivers.

Please check one of the following that apply and provide documentation such as an approved free and reduced lunch letter, tax records, public assistance records, or records of enrollment in an aid program. Counselors must have this information for auditing purposes.

- ☐ My child is enrolled in or eligible for the Free and Reduced-Price Lunch Program.
- ☐ My child is enrolled in a federal, state or local program that aids students from low-income families (e.g., TRIO programs such as Upward Bound).
- ☐ My child's annual family income falls within the Income Eligibility Guidelines set by the USDA Food and Nutrition Service (provided at [sat.org/fee-waivers](https://sat.org/fee-waivers)).
- ☐ My child's family receives public assistance.
- ☐ My child lives in federally subsidized public housing or a foster home or is homeless.
- ☐ My child is a ward of the state or an orphan.
