## Top 10 Ways to <u>Underwhelm</u> the Admissions Committee in Your College Essay

- 1. Using tricks to meet essay length requirements. (Ex: wider margins, larger font)
- 2. Writing clichés or using cliché words. (Ex: "eye-opening", "If I knew then what I know now")
- 3. Not answering the full prompt. If there are multiple layers to a prompt, address them all. If they ask for ONE item, do not write about three.
- 4. Writing to fill the page. Quality is more important than quantity.
- 5. Crossing the line from edgy to inappropriate. Do not write anything sexual, gross or tasteless.
- 6. No offensive language.
- 7. Using an overly self-effacing/arrogant tone.
- 8. Mentioning the wrong school/program. Don't send an essay to UNC talking about how much you like Duke.
- 9. Using an essay as an additional resume'.
- 10. Using spellcheck as a replacement for proofreading. "I tutored little kids every day after school" rather than "I tortured little kids every day after school".
