## ACCUPLACER at ASU- Beebe

The student must provide standardized test scores (ACT, ACCUPLACER) indicating that he/she meets the minimum placement test scores established for the course or program in which he/she wants to enroll.

### ACT

Minimum ACT composite score of 19

Minimum ACT Reading score of 19

Minimum ACT Math score of 19

Minimum ACT English score of 19

### ACCUPLACER

Minimum Accuplacer Reading score of 78 or higher

Minimum Accuplacer English/Writing score of 83 or higher

Minimum Accuplacer Math score of 42 or higher

Students must score at least a 19 on the ACT in English AND Reading to enroll in Freshman English I (78 in Reading and 83 in English on the ACCUPLACER) and at least a 19 on the ACT in Math and Reading to enroll in College Algebra (42 in Algebra on the ACCUPLACER). ASU-Beebe, ASU-Searcy, ASU-Heber Springs, and ASU-LRAFB administer the ACCUPLACER exam. Information regarding ACCUPLACER testing is available on our **Testing Services** website

### **Accuplacer Exam FAQs**

**How can I register for this exam?** Call 501-882-8812. **ASK for Tim Abbot**

**What is the Accuplacer exam?** Accuplacer is a computerized test that helps evaluate your skills and place you into appropriate courses. Accuplacer offers tests in Reading Comprehension, Sentence Skills, and Algebra/Mathematics. Accuplacer is a placement test – not an I.Q. test.

**How much does the test cost?** The Accuplacer test costs \$15 if you are taking one subject or all 3 sections.

**Where do I pay for the test?** You may pay at the Cashier's window in the State Hall building (1st floor) prior to testing. The Cashier's window accepts payment in the form of a check, money order, debit or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, and Discover Card), or cash.

**When is the exam offered?** Normal testing hours are Monday – Thursday, 9 AM – 2 PM. Fridays are by appointment only. Examinees should call 501-882-8812 for information regarding the testing schedule.

**What time should I arrive to the testing location?** Students should arrive 15 minutes before the exam is scheduled to begin.

**Can I use a calculator?** You may not use a hand-held calculator. There is one on the computer during the math portion of the test.

**What should I bring the day of the test?** You must bring the receipt you received from the Cashier's window at the time of testing and a valid photo ID with your name.

**When will I receive my scores?** You may print your results as soon as you complete your exam.

**What is the re-test policy?** You can retest the next available testing day to repeat any section of the Accuplacer exam. You can take the Accuplacer test a total of 3 times per 30 days.
