MINUTES OF THE BOARD MEETING ON NOVEMBER 22, 2021

The Antietam School District Board of Directors met for their voting meeting on November 22, 2021. Mr. James Glendening, Board President, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Mr. Glendening noted that the Board met in executive session after the Workshop meeting on November 15th to discuss a Personnel matter they did not re-convene. Mr. Glendening asked if there were any additions or corrections to the agenda. Mr. O'Boyle noted an error under the Treasurer's Report; Approval of Payment of Bills for October 2021 as listed, should have read - Approval of Payment of Bills for November 2021 as listed.

Dr. Rochlin stated that Winter Sports were gearing up and that she wished them well. The Spring Musical auditions have begun and they are going well. She had the pleasure of attending and being the guest speaker at the JNHS and NHS induction ceremony on November 17<sup>th</sup>. The district hosted a vaccination clinic where we vaccinated 61 students and she noted that the district's vaccination clinic for the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose will be on December 10<sup>th</sup>.
