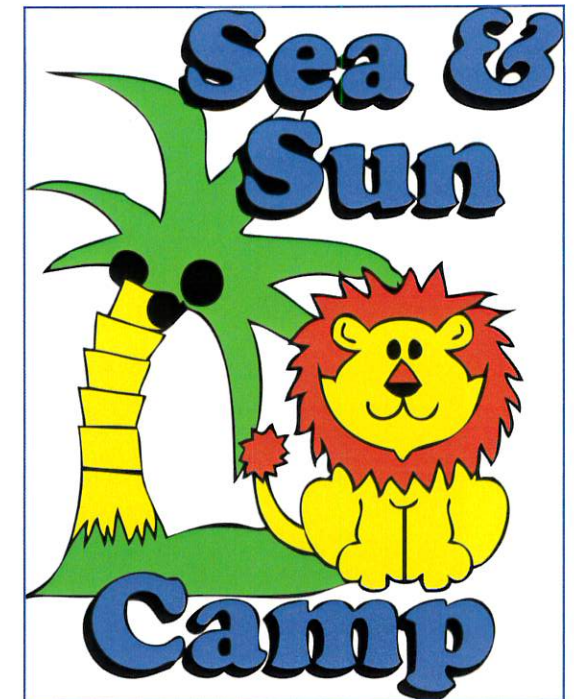

HISTORY

The Lions of Mississippi approved the Sea and Sun Camp as a State project at the State Convention held in Hattiesburg, Mississippi in May 1999. The first camp, begun by the Biloxi Lions Club, was held in 1997 at Sea Shore United Methodist Assembly before moving to Camp Wilkes in 2006.



PURPOSE

Our focus is to provide visually impaired children, ages five to sixteen, the opportunity to interact with their visually impaired peers through socialization and recreational activities.
