Mr. Roberts asked Dr. Rochlin for her Superintendent Report, Dr. Rochlin turned the floor over to Mr. Brian F. Boland.

Because of a letter received on Friday, August 18, 2023 from the Borough of Mt. Penn to the Antietam School District and the news interview by Mr. Troy Goodman, stating they were revoking occupancy permits for the Mt. Penn Elementary Center and Mt. Penn Primary Center. Mr. Boland, stated the time line of meetings, that had taken place between the Antietam School District and the Mt. Penn Borough since the flood of July 9, 2023, concerning occupancy of the remaining two buildings in the district; Mt. Penn Elementary Center, the Mt. Penn Primary Center and adding the occupancy of Trinity UCC since Option #1 plan was voted on by the Antietam School Board on Thursday, July 20, 2023. Mr. Boland discussed the numbers that could occupy each building as per the engineers. He pointed out that they have these numbers on file at the Mt. Penn Borough and we are not close to filling those buildings to capacity. Mr. Goodman said that satisfied the existing buildings. Mr. Boland then discussed the numbers for occupancy of Trinity UCC and we were not close to exceeding capacity, and also stated that the automatic fire alarm had been installed at Trinity UCC by the borough's recommended vendor and all that was needed was a test. It was verbally discussed between the Mt. Penn Borough and the School Board

that a test of the installed fire alarm would be done Monday, August 21, 2023, prior to the start of school so that a verbal on the occupancy of Trinity UCC could be given at the conclusion of the test.

Ms. Alarcon stated that they would discuss School Reopening 2023-2024.

Questions from the community regarding transportation, transitions from buildings, parking, were asked and answered.

With no motions to vote on nor anything further to discuss, Mr. Roberts thanked the community for attending and ajourned the meeting at 8:53 pm.
