 - Response on the issue from insurance:
 - Are phones covered for damage if they were to fall out of the holder?
 - **The coverage determination would depend on the facts of the incident, but they do have coverage for personal property of students that carries a \$250 deductible.**
 - Would theft of a phone also be covered?

- In most circumstances it would be, but typically student on student theft is not covered unless the insured is deemed liable. In this case, the phones would be in the custody of the insured. So, the teachers/staff need to be aware they have a high duty of care. They should be monitoring every phone going in and every phone going out. If one were to be stolen, a police report must be filed. Which would most likely result in finding the phone. We would not pay anything until a police report is filed and our claims team does a complete review of the incident.
