Mr. Faro moved to open nominations for temporary president Mrs. Storms seconded, and Mr. Roberts nominated Mrs. Storms as temporary president.

Solicitor Boland declared that nominations for temporary president be closed and called for a poll by Voice vote for the election of Mrs. Storms as temporary president the poll was unanimous. Solicitor Boland then turned the meeting over to Mrs. Storms.
