Dear Haddon Township School District Community,

I hope this message finds you well. I'd like to take a moment to follow up and clarify an item from yesterday's email and to celebrate some recent student achievements.

Please mark your calendars for our upcoming Community Forum on Monday, March 18, at 6:30 PM in the High School Auditorium. This will be an opportunity to learn more about our district's budget challenges and provide valuable feedback. I'd like to clarify that the potential tax increase figures I mentioned **apply only to the school tax portion of your property tax bill**, which makes up 55% of the total bill. Any increase eventually decided **should not** be estimated and applied to your total property tax bill but only to the school tax portion.
