

SAFETY FIRST RESPONSE:

IF THE STUDENT IS ACTIVELY ENGAGING IN SUICIDE BEHAVIOR

CALL 911

AND STOP THE BEHAVIOR IF IT IS SAFE TO DO SO



Suicide behavior indicates the student is in a psychiatric and potentially life threatening crisis that requires immediate community assessment.

Next Steps for Safety First Response for behavior:

1

Notify Administrator

2

Contact your Youth Service Officer (YSO) for assistance if needed

3

Contact parents/guardians (you do not need parent permission to call 911 when responding to safety concerns). If there are safety concerns call DHS Child Welfare at 855-503-7233.

4

Consult with another first aid trained staff person or Crisis Line 503-291-9111.

5

Fill out protocol if you have not already done so. It can be updated with a support plan after re-entry.

6

Re-entry meeting with parent/guardian and student and information from outside assessment before return to school.

Pause and reflect: are you okay?

Consider what support you need right now. Think about how you can continue to build your own resilience and process the vicarious trauma you experience.
