

WHITESBORO BOYS SOCCER BOOSTERS SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose: The Whitesboro Boys Soccer Boosters Senior Scholarship recognizes graduating seniors for their engagement in Whitesboro soccer as well as their academic accomplishments and participation in extracurricular activities.

Eligibility: A qualifying applicant is defined as a senior who has been a member of the Whitesboro Boys Soccer Program for at least two years.

Award availability: Scholarship distribution will depend on available funds. At minimum, there will be two \$600 scholarships awarded at the High School Awards Ceremony in June.

Application distribution: This scholarship form will be presented to each senior at the soccer banquet. Extra copies will be distributed by the Guidance Department during the spring term.

To apply, please follow the guidelines below:

1. Complete all sections of the application.
2. Attach High School Transcript.
3. Attach two letters of reference. At least one must be from a member of the Whitesboro staff who is familiar with your conduct and character as a student. The second letter may come from any person who is not a family member. References must include name and phone number.
4. Please respond to this essay question in 200–300 words:
What have you learned from playing soccer that will apply to the rest of your life?
5. Please give appropriate consideration to spelling and grammar in completing the application.

This scholarship application is due by the end of the school day on **Friday, May 2, 2025.**
