Over the weekend, Gabe Brough competed at the OHSAA Wrestling State tournament. Gabe wrestled well and finished the tournament 1-2, just missing All-Ohio honors. Congratulations again to Gabe on a fantastic season and being a state qualifier.

The Boys and Girls Track teams competed very well at the Indoor Track State Championships on Friday. Leah Emch highlighted the day with a 1st place finish in the 3200 meter run, which is the first indoor championship for a girl in school history. Other all-state performances included Kyrie Henline with a 7th place finish in the triple jump, Kevin Lewis taking 4th in the triple jump, Jesse Poiry placing 4th in the 60 meter hurdles, Dayquan Oliver placing 5th in the long jump, Jenna Gallant taking 2nd in the seated shot put, the boys 4x200 team taking 5th, and the girls 4x800 team placing 7th. There were also numerous relay teams and individuals recording finishes in Eastwood's top 10.

Congratulations to the High School Concert Band for earning a I (one) Superior rating at the Ohio Music Education Association Large Group Band Adjudicated Event held Friday at Sylvania Southview High School.
