

ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

The school district of residence of a student is defined by RSA 193:12, II.

All new resident students, accompanied by a parent/guardian, should register at school before opening day and as early as possible.

Any child entering school in the Governor Wentworth Regional School District for the first time must have proof of physical examination, immunization records, a copy of the child's birth certificate, proof of residency, and proof of custody if the child does not live with both natural parents.

Principals or their designee will meet with new students and parents/guardians to explain school programs.
