Measure R</p>	<p>Principal</p>	<p>Measure R</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School facilities measure bond • There was a facilities assessment by external company; including perceived improvements and costs per school • HVAC repair and replace \$231M • Security; cameras, clock/bell, fire alarm systems \$124M • \$1.39B to improve all schools, \$1.8B due to inflation over several years. • There will be priority of work • Mailer went out to San Jose community households • Pre-pandemic survey topic was affordable housing, can we use current district properties to turn into housing? Lenzen, Bouret, Broadway, Hillsdale (sites considered for transformation). If moving forward it would be only one site. • \$60 per \$100k property value. \$1.15B • Key features: Campus safety, heading, classroom and lab, affordable housing • There will be independent oversights, reports to community, performance audit • Schools can only improve like this thru bond measures. • Work will be done with Union laborers
