Example Calculation:

Total Grade Points: 4.0 (A) + 3.0 (B) + 4.5 (A in honors)
 + 2.0 (C) = 13.5

• Total Credits: 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 = 4


• GPA = $\frac{13.5}{4}$ = 3.375
