DISTRICT OVERVIEW


The Conestoga School District (#56) comprises approximately 198 square miles in Cass and Otoe Counties. The district is made up of the communities of Nehawka, Murray, Beaver Lake, Lake WaConDa (partial), and the surrounding rural areas. The district is organized as a PreK-12 educational program with the PreK-6 Building located in Murray and the 7-12 building located 2.5 miles west of Murray on Highway #1. Conestoga is classified as a Class III (PreK-12) district by the Nebraska Department of Education and a Class C1 school by the Nebraska School Activities Association. Conestoga is a member of the Capital Conference. The Conestoga School District is governed by a six-member board of education. The Board meets at the High School building in Murray the second Tuesday of the month. The meetings start at 5:00 PM, unless otherwise advertised. The 2024-2025 members of the Board of Education are: President Greg Page, Vice-President Candace Kelley, Secretary Jeremy Stone, Treasurer Tracey Priefert, and members Seth Ahrens and Teri Weisz.


CONESTOGA PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOUNDATION


The Conestoga Public Schools Educational Foundation is a non-profit organization that operates separately, but as an extension of the schools. The Conestoga Foundation Board of Trustees is made up of three school board members and two at large members. The Foundation was formed for acceptance of tax-deductible donations from interested supporters of education. Since the formation of the Foundation in 1989, donations of cash and equipment have been provided as memorials and contributions. Each year the Foundation awards scholarships to graduating seniors from the Conestoga Schools to further their education.

OTHER INFORMATION


- School is in session Tuesday through Friday, with a few exceptions as displayed on the district calendar.

- Cass County Head Start offers a satellite program at the elementary site. To contact this program, please call 402-235-2750














DISTRICT STATE CLASSIFICATIONS 2024




