The <u>New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA)</u> will be administered to all students in <u>Grade 11</u> this week (March 11th, 12th, 13th and 14th). <u>All 11th grade students</u> should report to their assigned testing location upon entering the school as testing is scheduled to begin promptly at <u>7:15am</u>.

<u>Students (Grade 9, 10 & 12) will report to school on a two-hour delay with Period 1 set to start at 9:30am.</u> Bus students should be aware that buses will start their second run around 9:15am. Please be patient as our drivers will get there as soon as possible.
