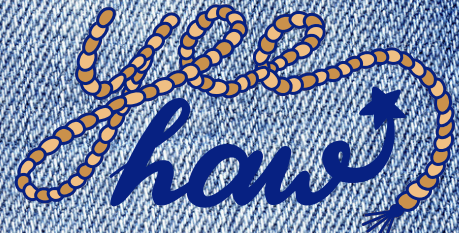
Students Enter Class.....7:45 AM
