

AGE OF ENTRANCE

A student may enter grade one if their chronological age will be six (6) before September 30th of the year of entering school.

A student may enter kindergarten if their chronological age will be five (5) before September 30th of the year of entering school.

A birth certificate must be presented upon registration as proof of the date of birth.

Incoming transfer students in grades 2-8, inclusive, will be initially placed in accordance with the data forwarded by the sending district. Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Superintendent or designee.

Incoming transfer students in grade 1 will only be initially admitted to grade 1 if their chronological age will be six (6) before December 31st of the year of entering school or if previously enrolled in grade 1 in another community and attending local schools only on a temporary basis (10 months or less). Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Superintendent or designee.
