Programs that support the academic growth of BUSD students.

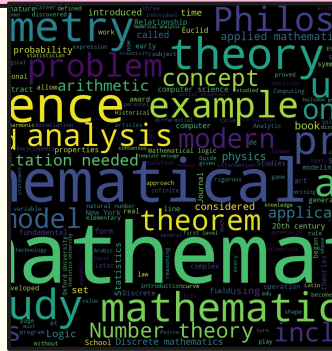
Social-Emotional

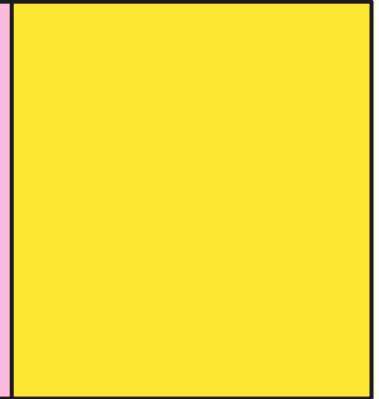
