He has served in numerous roles at the school-level and district-level; including classroom teacher, school principal, and assistant superintendent. Gary was a research associate with the Center for Research and Evaluation at the University of Maine. He served in numerous capacities for the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development. Gary participated on the Technical Review Committee for the Alaska State Assessment System and assisted with negotiations with US DOE for the NCLB Accountability Workbook Plan. Gary's interest in professional development for school principals was sparked in the 1980s by involvement with the International Network of Principals' Centers at Harvard University. Dr. Whiteley has been the Director of the Alaska Administrator Coaching Project for the last six years.

Our Tuesday presenter, **Lexie Domaradzki's**, primary areas of expertise are early childhood and kindergarten through Grade 12 reading, with emphases on research-based instruction for beginning readers and school reform. As a Research Associate at RMC Research, Ms. Domaradzki provided technical assistance on the implementation of Reading First grants to the Northwest State Cluster Team for the National Reading Technical Assistance Center. She also provides consultation and professional development services to the Alaska Staff Development Network in support of developing and implementing a data driven assessment system in the area of reading. Her responsibilities include coordinating with state and national stakeholders, conducting statewide webinars, and providing technical assistance to district and state leaders. Prior to joining RMC Research Ms. Domaradzki served as the

Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning for the Washington State Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction. During this time she worked actively with legislators, the Governor's office, the State Board of Education, and large education organizations to review policy and make recommendations.


