


### Q2 What do you feel are the main needs of your child(ren)?








### Q5 How well do the activities offered at your child's school match his or her interests?







## Q7 How often do you visit or call your child(ren)'s teacher or principal to talk about your child(ren)'s education?









## Q10 In your opinion, the Native Alaskan/Indian students in your school are given an equal opportunity to participate in classes, programs, and education when compared to other students?





# Q11 In your opinion, the Native Alaskan/Indian students in your school are given an equal opportunity to participate in sports and other after school programs when compared to other students?








