
Q1 What do you feel are the main educational needs of children in your community?




Q2 What educational programs are aligned to the tribal council's priorities and/or mission statement?







Q4 Overall, how well do the educational program and activities offered by the district match the priorities or mission statement of the Tribal Council?





Q5 How well do the Indian Policy & Procedures meet the needs of the Tribal Council? (see enclosed IPP's in the packet)





Q7 How likely, is the Tribal Council willing to appoint a Tribal Council representative to participate in the review and development of district programs?





Q8 Please select the best way for a Tribal Council representative to provide feedback about educational programs?










