Goal 1 - Reading

Goal 1 is to improve reading for K-5 students. Most teachers have received training in the ELA curriculum. There is a reading tutoring program being implemented for K-5 students. About 20% of actions/strategies are complete or implemented.

Goal 2 - Attendance

Goal 2 is about improving student attendance rates. The goal is for individual student attendance rates to increase by 10% from last year. As through the end of December, 42% of students were on track to meet that goal.

Goal 3 - Engagement

Goal 3 is to continue to develop effective engagement strategies for parents and community. The School Success Team is working on identifying an incentive for parent volunteers. The ultimate goal is to create an engagement plan.



Update on School Success Plan

In 2018, Twin Hills School was designated as a comprehensive support and intervention school (CSI) based on a number of performance indicators. As you may already know, Twin Hills School has been working on the implementation of a school success plan for the past three years based.

Twin Hills School will be receiving additional support through a new designation called CSI-MRI (more rigorous interventions). The School Success Team will continue to implement the success plan through the end of this year AND start the planning for the more rigorous interventions moving forward.
