Grow PA Scholarship Grant Program for Pennsylvania Students

Beginning in the 2025-26 academic year, Grow PA grants of \$5,000 will be available each year on a first-come, first-served basis to students who meet the following criteria:

- Must be a resident of Pennsylvania.
- Must be enrolled in a post-secondary education institution in Pennsylvania.
- Must pursue an educational program in an in-demand occupation.
- Must be willing to agree to live and work in Pennsylvania in an in-demand occupation for at least one year for each year they accept the scholarship.

If a student receives a grant, but does not complete the educational program or fails to meet other terms of the agreement, the scholarship is converted to a loan and must be repaid by the student.

Grow PA Tuition Waiver Program for Out-of-State Students

Beginning in the 2025-26 academic year, the Grow PA Tuition Waiver Program will allow eligible students to pay in-state tuition rates. Criteria to receive the waiver include:

- Must be a non-resident of Pennsylvania.
- Must be enrolled in a Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education school.
- Must pursue an educational program in an in-demand occupation.
- Must be willing to agree to live and work in Pennsylvania in an in-demand occupation for at least one year for each year they accept the waiver.

If a student receives a waiver, but does not complete the educational program or fails to meet other terms of the agreement, the waiver is converted to a loan and must be repaid by the student.

What Are In-Demand Occupations in PA?

In-demand occupations include agriculture, computer science, business, education, special education, STEM education, engineering, nursing, allied health, criminal justice and other programs as approved by PHEAA.

The list of in-demand occupations will be adjusted regularly to reflect Pennsylvania's workforce needs.
