High School Office Info

When school is in session, the High School office is open Monday-Friday between 6:45am-3:45pm. When arriving, press the bell button by the main doors under the large ENTRANCE sign, and we will unlock it for you to come in.

Raptor- Visitor Check-in

ALL visitors need to present a drivers license or state ID to be run through the District's security Raptor check when entering the main office. Once you are checked in, you will <u>receive and must wear</u> a Raptor visitor sticker visibly on the upper front part of your body. (It is a white sticker that has a black & white photo from your driver's license, and includes the word Visitor across the top) After your visit, please return to the main office to return the sticker and be signed out.

Visitor parking is in the front row and please **DO NOT** park in a numbered spot. You will need to register your vehicle in the office when checking in, so please memorize or take a picture of your license plate before entering the building.

Lunch Account Balance Information

Students will be permitted to purchase meals from the District's food service using either cash on hand or a food service account. A student may be allowed to incur a negative food service account balance subject to the following conditions.

Students may be permitted to accumulate negative food service account balance as determined by the District Administrator. The District Administrator shall determine the manner of determining permissible account balances by grade level. A student shall not be permitted to purchase a la carte items without sufficient account balance or cash on hand.

Students that are receiving free or reduced price meals will be permitted to purchase a USDA approved meal if the student has the necessary funds with him/her to purchase the meal, regardless of whether the student has a negative account balance.

This policy and any implementing guidelines shall be provided in writing to all households at the start of each school year and to households transferring to the school or School District during the school year. The policy and implementing guidelines will also be provided to all District staff with responsibility for enforcing the policies. The policy and guidelines will be posted on the District website.



- Teens will not be allowed to apply for their probationary license until they are at **least 16 years old**, **hold** their permit for at least 6 months ticket free, practice hours of at least 50 hours and 10 of those at night, and have completed all of driver education (classroom and BTW lessons).
- Another change is that the **permit will be good for 18 months** instead of 12 months. All 16-17 year olds **will have to take the road test.**
- The new law changes the number of practice hours required during the permit phase, it changed from **30** hours to **50** hours. The DMV does not collect the practice driving record when teens go for their road test however they may ask to see it or the **Road Ready app** which also tracks practice time.
- Your teen should work toward at least *100 hours of practice with 30 of those at night* based on national recommendations put forth by AAA Foundation research in order to give novice drivers more experience before licensing (shows it reduces crashes after licensing). Our common goal for everyone is to have fewer crashes, injuries, and fatalities involving teens and all other drivers. Use of the Road Ready app is a great tool for them to track their progress of practice hours.

Who is eligible to enroll? Any student who is 14 years/10 months to 18 years old. Sign up information is located on the De Pere High School webpage under the "Students" tab under the Driver's Education link. Ice Bears Capture 2nd State Title in 3 Years

Congratulations to the Bay Area Ice Bears girls hockey team for winning the WIAA State Championship last weekend in Middleton. The Ice Bears beat the Central Wisconsin Storm 8-0 in the title game. Bay Area completed a 27-1 season with its only loss coming against a Minnesota team.

In the championship, DPHS senior Julianne B tallied one goal and two assists while senior Rachael B added one goal.

The Ice Bears also won state titles in 2023 and 2014.

Brooke C. Wins 3rd State Title, Beckett Claims Runner-Up at State Wrestling

Congratulations to senior Brooke C who captured her third WIAA girls wrestling state championship on March 1 in Madison. She won four matches in the 100-pound bracket at State, including a 13-9 decision over Katherine Cook of Freedom in the final. Brooke C also won titles in 2022 and 2023, and was runner-up in 2024.

She completed her high school career with records of 64-20 (vs boys) and 39-1 (vs girls) and is the first 4-time state placewinner for De Pere.

Senior Mycah B (49-4) finished runner-up among Division 1 132-pound boys, in his fourth state appearance. Mycah B also was runner-up as a sophomore and fourth as a junior.

He is De Pere's career wins leader with a 174-20 record. He's the third 3-time state placewinner in program history, joining Shane Corrigan and Michael Alexander.

De Pere's other state qualifier, sophomore Olin N, went 1-2 at the tournament at 138 pounds. He finished 46-5 overall.

All-Conference Honors

Congrats to the Redbirds named to Fox River Classic all-conference teams.

Boys Basketball: First team – Zach K and Pryce G; Second team – Roan D; Honorable mention – Connor H. Zach K also earned Player of the Year honors and was named to the all-defensive team. Roan D was chosen Defensive Player of the Year. Brian Winchester was named Coach of the Year for leading the Redbirds to an 18-0 conference record for the third straight season.

Girls Basketball: First team – Egan B, Jaden C, and Abby T; Honorable mention – Aubree F and Addy D. Jaden C and Addy D were also named to the all-defensive team. Jeremy Boileau was named Coach of the Year as the Redbirds posted an 18-0 record.

Wrestling: First team boys – Mycah B, Seth C and Olin N; Second team boys – Grady G, Jack G, Brandon V; Honorable mention boys – Brice B.

First team girls – Brooke C; Second team girls – Margo G.

Mycah B and Brooke C were named co-wrestlers of the year for boys and girls, respectively.
