Internet Resources:

WI DOJ - Internet Crimes against Children

Offers many resources to assist with teaching internet safety to kids. Includes the PKO (Protect Kids Online) podcast which has many episodes that discuss all things kids do on the internet.

Common Sense Media

This site offers reviews of all things media. Curious about an app? Search it here. It will tell you what things to watch out for as well as what other parents and kids say about the app. Can also review movies, video games and more. **This site used to be free but now requires a subscription (\$30/year or \$3/month). You do get 3 free reviews.

National Center for Missing and Exploited Children

A great resource for information on sexting, sextortion, and sex trafficking. Also offers educational resources on internet safety for kids under the Education tab.

Stopbullying.gov

This site talks about bullying and cyberbullying. Offers many resources from how to deal with haters to what apps kids are using and the dangers associated with them.

Entertainment Software Rating Board (ESRB)

This is the board that reviews and gives ratings to all video games. It's similar to ratings given to movies. You can find a rating for the game as well as a description for why that rating was given. Also content descriptors to support the rating such as, comic mischief, cartoon violence to blood and gore, drugs, language, and sex. A great resource when trying to decide if a game is ok to play.
