 - g. Humboldt City School District – Humboldt, TN
 - h. Jackson – Madison County School District – Jackson, TN
2. The applicant must be a high school senior enrolling in an institution of higher education (vocational school, college or university, etc.) or have recently completed military service and will be attending higher education for the first time.
3. Scholarship priority will be placed on applicants who come from an agriculture background and/or who plan to pursue a career in agriculture, food manufacturing or a business-related field.
