## **RULES:**

- 1. Candidates for this award shall be daughters, stepdaughters, sons, stepsons, grandsons, step-grandsons, granddaughters, step-granddaughters, great-granddaughters, step-great-granddaughters, great-grandsons, step-great-grandsons of veterans who served in the Armed Forces during eligibility dates for membership in The American Legion/Auxiliary.
  - a. April 6,1917 through November 11, 1918 (World War I)
  - b. December 7,1941 through December 31,1946 (World War II/US Merchant Marines)
  - c. June 25,1950 through January 31,1955 (Korean War)
  - d. February 18,1961 through May 7,1975 (Vietnam War)
  - e. August 24,1982 through July 31,1984 (Grenada and Lebanon)
  - f. December 20,1989 through January 31,1990 (Panama)
  - g. August 2,1990 to the date of cessation of hostilities (Persian Gulf to present)
- 2. Applicants must be in their senior year of high school at Glencoe-Silver Lake Public School or a current American Legion or Legion Auxiliary member. Also a non-traditional student who is just beginning or continuing his/her education after High School.
- 3. The scholarship must be used within 12 months of the date the winner received notification by the scholarship committee or it will be forfeited.
- 4. Applicants must present the completed application to the Silver Lake American Legion Auxiliary on or before March 1.
- 5. The scholarship award money will be given to the recipient as soon as we receive their end of semester/grade point average report. This is to verify that the individual is attending college or technical school.
- 6. The scholarship aware money should be applied for as soon as possible, preferable before the end of the year. If the person does not meet these criteria, then the money will be awarded to an alternate.
