  - c) The applicant's intended field of work or vocation.
  - d) The accredited college or technical college the applicant plans to attend.
- 2. A letter or recommendation from a teacher is optional
- 3. All graduates of Glencoe-Silver Lake High School are eligible for these scholarships, but preference will be given to applicants from the Silver Lake area.
- 4. Payment of the scholarship award shall be made upon request by the recipient and upon receipt of the first post-secondary semester grade report. This is to verify that the recipient is attending a post-secondary institution. Recipients should request payment as soon as possible after he or she obtains the grade report.
- 5. This application <u>and the typed statement</u> should be turned in at the High School Counseling Office.
