As part of our district's commitment to promote a sense of student belonging, all students at Lower Moreland Middle School are being asked to complete a survey that focuses on students' sense of belonging within the school community. A positive school climate supports successful learning. The purpose of this survey is to find out the extent to which students feel personally accepted, respected, included, and supported by others in the school.

Students will complete the Belonging Survey, which consists of 20 Likert scale questions, during WIN classes during the week of March 24th. The survey is anonymous and should take approximately 15-20 minutes to complete. Participation in the survey is voluntary.

The school will use the survey results to create an action plan and guide our district goal of creating a climate of inclusion and safety.
