

















## Innovative Math Programs for the 25-26 School Year



We are visiting schools to see the math programs in classrooms!






Our Math classes, K-12, are using a supplemental resource called Magma Math to create opportunities for deeper student-driven discourse and collaboration.

Students gain valuable insights into civic participation while learning research and public speaking skills.








The Middle School Capstone Project is designed to give students a meaningful and foundational civic experience before they enter high school. The project should reflect the elements listed below:

We created an engaging, welcoming and fun lunch/recess program with choice-based activities where students can positively interact with one another and take a brain break to re-energize student learning in the afternoon!














- Total cost of the project is aidable through BOCES Arts in Education











## Completing the Continuum

We are delighted to announce that this budget supports a full-time ICT model at both Manor and Harbor Elementary Schools!











