SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

The following rules and regulations apply to the clearance of all Maricopa Unified School District #20 volunteers.

Level 1 - General Volunteers

Volunteers who assist with school activities under the supervision of a district employee. This includes office helpers, cafeteria workers, library aides, PTO volunteers, and event volunteers. These are occasional or sporadic volunteers. These volunteers must complete the following:

- 1. Provide the school site with a valid driver's license and check in with Visitor Aware.
- 2. Be approved by the Site Administrator.
- 3. Sign in whenever visiting a school site.

Level 2 - Approved Volunteers

Volunteers who work with students on a recurring basis in roles that require additional clearance, such as regular classroom volunteers, athletic program volunteers, and those supporting student activities beyond occasional events. All volunteers for over-night field trips are Level 2 volunteers. These volunteers must complete the following:

- 1. Apply online to be a Maricopa Unified School District #20 volunteer through Visitor Aware.
- 2. Provide the school site with a valid driver's license and check in with Visitor Aware.
- 3. Attend a monthly MUSD volunteer training at district office.
- 4. Be approved by the Site Administrator.
- 5. Sign in whenever visiting a school site.

All volunteers will be supervised by a district employee at all times. Volunteers will receive identification badges based on their level.
