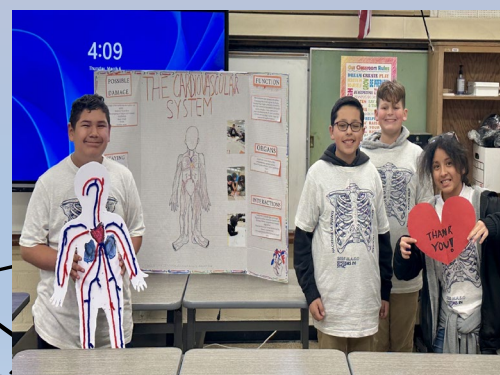
Middle School Math and Science Olympiad 2025

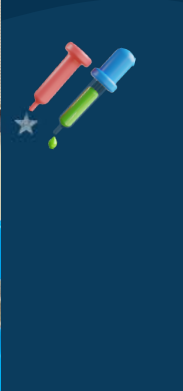
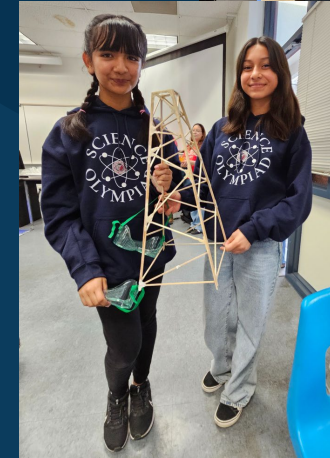
