## TAX PREPARATION HELP

The AARP Foundation Tax-Aide program offers free, individualized tax preparation for low- to moderate-income taxpayers—especially those 50 and older. The closest center where such services are available to Vienna area residents is the Jim Scott Community Center, 3001 Vaden Drive in Fairfax. You may walk in or make an appointment; appointments will be posted two weeks in advance. Taxes are prepared on most Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays. There will be no services available on April 1, and the last day to receive tax preparation assistance is Saturday, April 12.

If you wish to use Tax-Aide, the best thing to do is to go to its website, [novataxaide.org/sites/jim-scott-community-center](http://novataxaide.org/sites/jim-scott-community-center), where you'll see instructions to prepare for your visit and to make an appointment. If you still have questions, call 703.496.4170.

You may also avail yourself of Tax-Aide services at Reston Community Center, 2310 Colts Neck Road in Reston, where appointments are preferred. They're open on Tuesdays 9 am-2 pm, Thursdays 4:30-8:30 pm, and on Saturdays 9 am-3 pm. Call 703.651.6858 for information and to make an appointment.

## ABOUT HEARING LOSS

This is a common condition that affects millions of older adults worldwide. As we age, changes in our hearing can significantly impact our quality of life, yet it often goes undetected and untreated. Having a hearing screening is crucial, especially for older adults. Screenings provide

early detection, can help with overall health issues linked to cognitive decline, social isolation, depression, and an increased risk of falls. They will also help to improve relationships with family and friends, reducing misunderstandings and frustration, and will assist in providing a better quality of life.

The screening is quick and painless, conducted by an audiologist or hearing care professional, and typically involves just a few things. They are: a hearing history, a physical examination of the ears, and a hearing test. If hearing loss is detected, your provider will discuss treatment options which may include hearing aids, cochlear implants, or lifestyle changes to protect your remaining hearing.

The Fairfax County Health Department conducts hearing tests at its clinics in Alexandria, Fairfax, and Reston. Evaluations are completed by licensed audiologists who are certified. Hearing services in the clinics are offered on a sliding fee scale, based on household income. Hearing is a vital part of staying connected to the world around you. Don't wait to take the first step toward better hearing and a better quality of life.

## EL SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

16 de marzo de 2025

### Perspectiva salesiana

El libro del Génesis y el Evangelio de Lucas describen dos escenas muy poderosas en las que la voluntad de Dios se demuestra claramente sin ninguna oportunidad de error. Abraham presenció el misterioso brasero como símbolo del pacto de Dios con él y sus descendientes, mientras que Pedro, Juan y Santiago presenciaron la transfiguración de Jesús.

Es difícil pasar por alto el mensaje en estos casos: se trata de manifestaciones y expresiones directas de la voluntad de Dios, su deseo y sueño de que todos los que vivan una vida centrada en Dios aquí en la tierra experimenten la plenitud de esa vida para siempre en el cielo.

¡Si tan solo la voluntad de Dios fuera siempre tan fácil de entender! ¡Si tan solo pudiéramos discernir siempre la voluntad de Dios para nosotros y para los demás! ¡Si tan solo pudiéramos saber exactamente lo que Dios quiere de nosotros en cada momento con absoluta claridad! ¡Si tan solo Dios hablara a todos a través de la transfiguración de la luz o del humo!

Por supuesto, para la mayoría de nosotros, esto no sucede. Ya que este tipo de comunicaciones están a nuestro alcance, ¿cómo podemos discernir la voluntad de Dios para nosotros? San Francisco de Sales sugiere una serie de cosas que pueden ayudarnos a reconocer la voluntad de Dios en nuestras

vidas... y cómo esa voluntad debería afectar nuestras relaciones con los demás.

Primero, observe los Diez Mandamientos y otros consejos que se encuentran en las Escrituras; considere la tradición, la enseñanza, las prácticas y la autoridad de la Iglesia; preste atención a las obligaciones y responsabilidades que los acompañan en el estado y la etapa de su vida. Así, por ejemplo, si está casado, trabaja y tiene una familia, la voluntad de Dios para usted incluiría cosas como asistir a la misa del sábado, honrar a su padre y a su madre, nutrir su relación con su cónyuge, satisfacer las necesidades de sus hijos y enseñarles, hacer su trabajo de manera amable, justa y ética, equilibrar las demandas del trabajo, el descanso, el hogar y la oficina, etc., etc.

Segundo, observe las circunstancias, situaciones y relaciones en las que se encuentra cada día, cada hora, cada momento. Presta atención a cómo las demandas y necesidades de los demás pueden ser expresiones de la voluntad de Dios para ti.

Por último, sé paciente. Confía en el amor de Dios por ti. Si bien las revelaciones de Dios son a veces inconfundibles, la mayoría son más sutiles y se revelan gradualmente: pueden llevar toda la vida.


