### LEARNING SNAPSHOTS

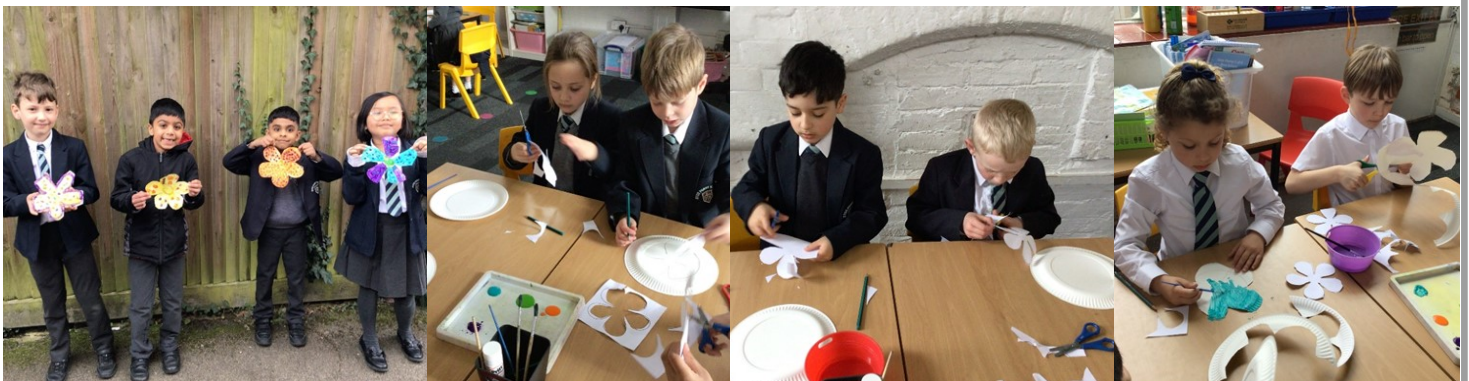
**Year 1** have really enjoyed learning about length and height in Maths this week. They have been using the words 'shorter' 'taller' and 'longer' to compare objects. The children have been using cubes and measuring how many cubes long different objects in the classroom are.

**Ask me: To compare the length and height of different objects.**



**Year 2** learnt about the works of Japanese artist Yayoi Kusama and we produced our own Kusama inspired art works. We have also been preparing our performance for the upcoming dance festival which we are very excited about! In maths we have started learning about mass, capacity and volume.

**Ask me: What is Yayoi Kasuma famous for and which pattern does she like?**





**Year 3** had an exciting visit from Mad Science this week, where they explored electromagnetism. They have participated in magnet investigations and explored static energy during the workshop. They also found out more about the artist LS Lowry and begun learning how to draw figures in their new art project People and places. In PE, they learnt about new ways of dodging and applied their skills in a game running the gauntlet.

**Ask me: When two magnet push away from each other, what is it called?**



**Year 4** have been very busy this week starting with a visit from Mad Science where they were looking at the changing states of matter and some chemistry. The children really enjoyed the workshop and had great fun participating in all the fun experiments. We also were lucky enough to go to the natural history museum at Eton College for a session based on the classification of animals. It was a great session and the children were great representatives for the school.

**Ask me: What is a vertebrates and invertebrates?**



**Reception** had a go at making fruit salad this week to support our learning about having a healthy diet. We discussed the importance of eating five a day and drinking plenty of water. After washing their hands the children used kitchen equipment to peel, chop and mix their chosen fruits and were encouraged to try a fruit that they may not have had before.

**Ask me: What did you put in your fruit salad and which fruit did you enjoy the most?**
