CCPS Celebrates Significant Increase in its 2024 CCRPI Single Score

The score, based on CCRPI data is 18.6 points above 2023 score

JONESBORO - Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) is pleased to announce that based on calculations completed by the Governor's Office of Student Achievement (GOSA), the district has demonstrated a double digit increase in its **CCRPI Single Score**. Released recently, the district's 2024 score of 70.2 points reflected an increase of 18.6 points over the 2023 score of 51.6. GOSA used College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) data to calculate the Single Score.

"We are excited about this improvement and what it means for our students and staff," said Dr. Anthony W. Smith, CCPS Superintendent/CEO of Schools. "The Single Score of 70.2 points shows improvement in those key areas that contribute to the district's overall CCRPI performance."

About the GOSA Single Score

Championed by the Governor's Office of Student Achievement, HB 1122 requires GOSA to "establish and annually calculate individual school and school system ratings as a single numerical score on a scale of 0-100, for each public school and school system in this state." GaDOE is required to calculate and publish component scores as well as publish GOSA's single score.

As of late February, state-, district-, and school-level CCRPI reports now include a feature that lists the GOSA Single Score. This score is calculated by the Governor's Office of Student Achievement and is required by state law to be published by GaDOE.
