Eco Engineers!

(June 30 - August 21)

Over the course of our 8-week summer camp, Northsiders will emerge as creative scientists, exploring the worlds of both natural and applied sciences through an artistic lens. Campers will engage in hands-on explorations into the topics of plant and animal life, engineering, digital arts, and sustainability. Taking advantage of our spacious rooftop playground, sprinkler setup and garden, Northsiders will also be treated to a daily dose of unstructured outdoor play, as we make the most of the summer sun!



July: Exploring Nature + Sustainability Through Creativity (June 30-July 11)

Discovering the Natural World (plants, insects, and more)

During the first two weeks of camp, campers will engage in explorations into the beauty and complexity of the natural world. Focusing their investigations on plants, insects, and their habitats, campers will use artistic offerings, such as collaging, painting, print-making and design to both gain understanding and share their learning. These first two weeks will also be used to introduce our campers to our rooftop garden, home to a variety of plant and animal life.

(July 14-July 25)

Repurposing & Recycling – Giving New Life to Old Materials

During the last two weeks of Session 1, campers will extend their nature studies into the area of sustainability. They will learn how to use recycled materials, natural resources, and eco-friendly techniques to create meaningful art, while gaining a deeper understanding of their impact on the environment, and how we can work together to build a more sustainable future.

August: Little Engineers: Constructing Learning

(July 28-August 8)

Building + Design for a Greener Future

August kicks off our explorations into STEAM learning, bridging the gap between the arts and sciences. During the first two weeks of Session 2, campers will explore all areas of design and construction, paying particular attention to how engineering can be used to solve real-life problems!

(August 11-August 21)

Movement + Motion in Design

In the final two weeks of camp, campers will dig into the concept of *motion*: What makes things move? How can we make things move? Campers will take on challenges, such as creating cars that move and catapults that launch, all using recycled materials. They will also deepen their understanding of the concepts of force and gravity through artistic offerings, such as painting and dance!



Enrichment Offerings and Descriptions

Music and Movement

Campers will explore the connection between music, movement, and sustainable innovation! Using recycled materials, they'll create their own instruments and experiment with sound, rhythm, and teamwork. Movement activities will have them building bridges with their bodies, spinning like wind turbines, and flowing like rivers to reinforce engineering concepts in a fun and interactive way.

Sports

Campers will build their body awareness, balance, coordination, strength, and self-esteem through a variety of sports adventures. They will learn the importance of teamwork, delegation, and how their position in a space affects others.

Gardening

In this hands-on gardening class, young eco-engineers will explore how plants grow and how we can help the earth thrive! Campers will dig, plant, and water their own mini gardens while learning about composting, pollinators, and the magic of soil. Through fun experiments, they'll discover how worms, sun, and rain work together like nature's tiny engineers. Using recycled materials, they'll also build simple garden structures like seed starters and watering tools. This class encourages curiosity, creativity, and a love for the environment—one little sprout at a time!

Field Day Fridays

On each Friday of the summer, campers will be challenged with a new and exciting structured gross motor exploration. This will range from STEAM activities like designing recycled vehicles, to water balloon ring tosses!

Class Sizes & Ratios

- Class sizes will range from 8 to 17 depending on the age of the children
- Each class will be assigned one Head Counselor and a minimum of one Assistant Counselor

Additional information

- Diapers, wipes and sun lotion are provided by school
- All meals and snacks will be provided by Northside's Community Kitchen and prepared by the head chef and kitchen team.
- We are a nut-free school!
- Each class will have a designated area on the first floor for stroller, scooter, or bicycle parking during the camp day.

- Arrival will be 8:30AM

Registration Fees and Refund Policy

Registrations Received By 3/31

- \$100 deposit per week due during registration
- Installments due 4/15, 5/15, 6/15
- Families may pay in full during registration if preferred

Registrations Received Between 4/1 and 4/30

- \$200 deposit per week due during registration
- Installments due 5/15, 6/15
- Families may pay in full during registration if preferred

Registrations Received after 5/1-5/31

- 50% due during registration
- Remaining 50% installment due 6/15

Refund Policy

- Up to May 15, if a cancellation is made families may receive a full refund (minus a \$100 change fee)
- Cancellation up to 14 days prior to the start date: families may receive a 50% a refund (minus a \$100 change fee)
