#### WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?



Where: Town Hall Council Chambers (and Zoom)


#### WHAT INFORMS THE PREFERRED OPTIONS?

- **Benchmarking Metrics**: Identified by the SABC. These include security priorities, programming priorities, and facility priorities. See the benchmarking matrices for the 5 initial options **HERE**.
- Community Survey Feedback
- School Board Priorities: Board of Education guidance on the benchmarking metrics.
- \$70-130M Project Budget: Supported by the community in the June 2024 survey. The majority of respondents said they would support an annual tax impact of \$200-400.

# **Amazing Professional Development Day Today!**

Many of you might be curious about what goes on during teacher workshop days. Well, today was nothing short of incredible! The theme for the day was "Making Content Accessible." It all began with an inspiring presentation from two of our own Blue Point staff members, Christy LoCicero-Mackey and Tracey Frederick. Using American Sign Language, they engaged in a conversation to highlight the important work they do every day to make learning



more accessible for the students in their self-contained classroom. Their presentation was truly moving and left everyone with goosebumps!

Afterwards, staff had the opportunity to choose from a variety of sessions, many of which were led by 30 of our talented Scarborough Schools' staff members who shared their expertise with their colleagues. While a few sessions were facilitated by outside consultants, most were led by our own team. Topics covered a wide range of subjects, including topics such as support for district-

specific applications, executive functioning, differentiation, brain-based learning, high-impact instructional strategies, AI in classrooms, neurodiversity, and support for multilingual learners.

Looking at the day as a whole, the sessions offered valuable takeaways that will help further support all learners. These workshop days are essential for giving our staff the time and resources they need to grow professionally and continue making a difference in our students' lives.

# 2025-2026 School Calendar Approved!



At last evening's board meeting, the board approved the 2025-2026 calendar. It is very similar to this year's calendar, and will allow for up to three "traditional snow days" (or any type of unplanned "no school" days). If more than the allotted three days are needed, those days will be **asynchronous** remote learning days, consistent with how the school calendar has looked like for the past few years.

# Update to Cellphone Policy- JFCK

At the Feb 27th School Board meeting, after months of review by the Policy Committee, the Board voted to amend the Cellphone Policy, JFCK, Use of Privately Owned Electronic Devices at School. Update to the policy is linked <a href="here">here</a>. This policy will go into effect on April 28, when we return from April break. This will allow the HS administration time to develop their protocols and response continuum to align with the updated expectations. # 2025-2026 Kindergarten Registration NOW OPEN!



We are eager to begin planning to welcome our newest students to Scarborough Public Schools for Kindergarten in 2025- 2026! As of this week, we now have 143 students, pre-registered, with 5 months to go.

- Kindergarten is open to any student who turns 5 on or before Oct. 15, 2025.
- If your child meets this criteria, and you are sending them to school in the fall, please complete the form linked here NOW: New Student Enrollment Form
- If your child meets the age requirement, but you are undecided about sending them due to their age or developmental level, please complete the REGISTRATION FORM anyway. This will help us plan for all potential students.

- Appointments will be scheduled later this spring in each of our schools to review paperwork, including notarization of residency.
- If your child has specific health concerns, you can call or set up an appointment with one of our school nurses at any time.
- More information will be provided throughout the spring!




